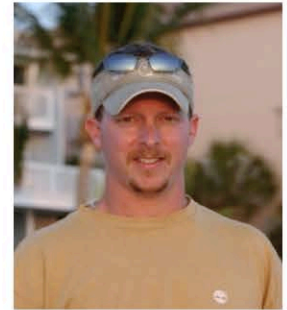

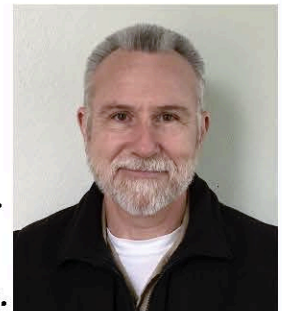


Desired Future Conditions of Seven Bends State Park
