Seven Bends State Park Update

On August 30th the Department of Conservation and Recreation held a public meeting to discuss potential changes to the Seven Bends State Park Master Plan. One of the biggest proposed changes was the elimination of a road linking the two sides of the Park. Construction of this road on the side of Massanutten Mountain poses both engineering and environmental challenges.

About 30 people attended and several shared concerns about the access to the Park on narrow roads. DCR is considering all the input.

Over the next several months you will likely see Park Closed signs. The demolition of buildings requires the Park to shut down entirely for safety reasons.

We are looking forward to picnic shelters, vault toilets, and hand-carry canoe/kayak launches for next summer. You'll hear a lot more from us about the Park's eventual opening in 2019.


Summer Camps 2018


